Anesthesia/Surgery Options and Associated Fees:

Pre-Anesthetic Blood Profile: Includes a Complete Blood Count (CBC), 2 liver and 2 kidney function tests, as well as protein levels, blood glucose, and electrolytes (Optional only for spays, neuters, and declaws on dogs and cats under 1 year of age, Required for all other anesthetic procedures.) The cost of this service is \$76.00

Pre-Anesthetic Electrocardiogram: Sent via modem to a cardiology group in New York (Cardiopet). This procedure evaluates the electrical activity of the heart in preparation for anesthesia (Required for pets 7 yrs. of age and over, but highly recommended for *all* pets prior to anesthesia). The cost of this service is \$89.00.

Surgical Laser Option: Our surgery suite is equipped with a CO2 Laser that produces less pain, less bleeding, and less swelling than that of traditional surgery. We believe this reduces the risk of infection, returns the patient to normal activity sooner, and provides the surgeon better precision. The cost of this service above the traditional surgery fee is usually \$139.50, but may vary based on the procedure. The veterinarian will be happy to call you prior to surgery if the laser fee is going to be greater than \$139.50. (NOTE: Declawing procedures in the cat are always performed using the laser, and are included in the declaw fee.)
